








New KPI for Process Safety: LoPC






LoPC = unintended release of substance or energy with
a) Lost time injury (≥1d) and/or fatality or
b) Fires or explosions resulting ≥ € 20,000 of direct cost or
c) Substance release ≥ defined release threshold quantities
