

## Overview

A summary of the first FG2 seminar, held in Budapest. The papers and presentations from that seminar are contained here for view and comment.

**Opening presentations** were heard from:

- Lee Allford (giving the EPSC perspective),
- István Jelinek (who gave an introduction to Chinoi),
- and from Rob Cotterill (who gave a welcome to FG2 and described how the next two days would work).

An instructive tour was then held, of the Chinoi facility, which provided many delegates with the opportunity to ask many questions about pharmaceuticals, and about process industry in Hungary.

The first main session opened after lunch, with a talk from David Embrey on a **method for defining procedures that meet best practice**. After much discussion, Peter Bull gave an interesting talk on **establishing effective training arrangements**.

Conversation continued on the second day, despite an enjoyable evening sampling fine Hungarian wines. Oyvind Kaasa spoke on **maintaining special attention, when critical safety systems are inhibited** and Gareth Hughes gave a presentation covering several **issues related to task design**.

Throughout the seminar, discussions happened, both in freeform and in groups. These were recorded, and have been used as inputs into the best practice guidance.
